



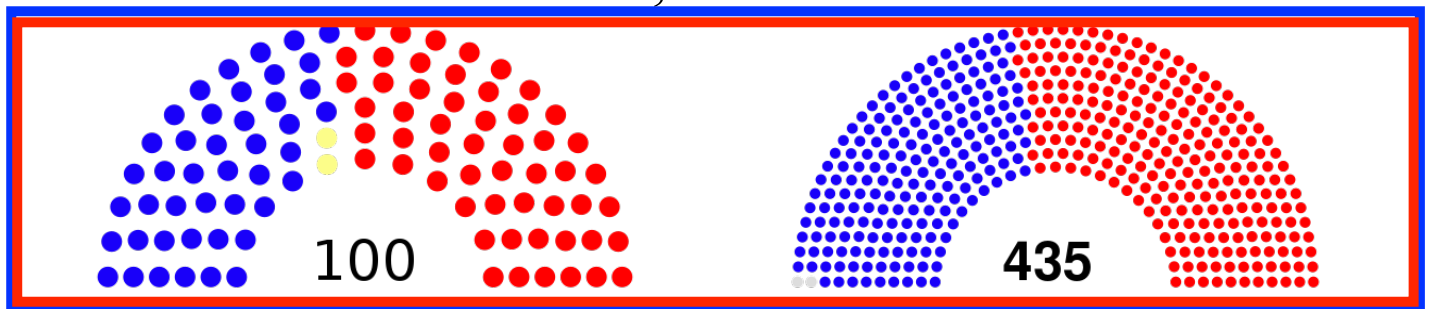
## Political Participation and the 2018 Midterms
